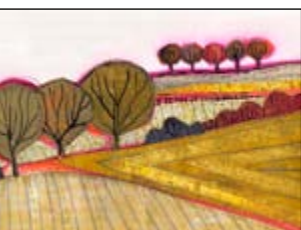

Opening hours **10.00am to 4.00pm** unless otherwise stated on artist's entry

Join us for late Spring Bank Holiday weekend and visit one or more of nearly **250** artists and makers showcasing their work across the county. This annual event is run by, with and for artists celebrating the creativity and passion of Derbyshire creators.

- All artists listed by venue from 1 in the south to 68 in the north, with a **map** in the middle pages.
- Alphabetical **index** of artists at back of brochure.
- Each artist's entry gives the full address and brief directions. Maps and **what3words** (route finding app) can be found on the artist's webpage.
- If a venue or individual artist is not open on certain days or times, there will be a **green dot** above the artist's name, then see the green text for more information.
- Each artist has a **code** in the venue number box:
 - C = commissions taken
 - T = teaching, workshops, demonstrations or talks undertaken
 - P = preview evening on Friday 23rd May - all are welcome (the website has a search filter to find artists holding previews). Or contact the artist for times and details
 - D = full disabled access
 - d = partial disabled access or assistance may be required (the search filter on the website will show those with disabled access or contact the artist for more information).
- Some artists exhibit in their **own studio**, some in multi-artist venues. You can get different experiences by visiting a range of venues. Please visit single artists and small venues, they'd love to see you!
- Only interested in ceramics? Want to see everyone in Derby? Like to visit studios? Use our website www.derbyshireopenarts.co.uk to search for **Genre**, **Location** and **Solo Artist**.
- Create your own **artists trail**, including map, on our website. Click on My Favourites and Trails button at the top of the page for full instructions.
